

Panhandle Gymnastics Group Policies

ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE

A \$75 group registration fee is required and added to the first months tuition.

PAYMENT POLICY

Tuition is due prior to the first class of each month, and automatic payments are processed on the 23rd of the month. Regular rates apply September through May. A late fee of \$15.00 will be added to your tuition if payment is not received in a timely manner. Panhandle Gymnastics closes for major holidays. Summer (June, July, August) classes/camps will differ from regular school year classes. We accept cash, check, or Visa/Mastercard at Panhandle Gymnastics. Drops in enrollment must be submitted by the 15th of the month prior to the drop for the account to not be charged.

CLASS MAKE UP POLICY

In any event that a group misses a class, or the gym is required to close due to weather or other circumstance; classes are to be made up at another day/time. Any student make up day must be approved through the office prior to student attending the make-up class.

PRICING

Group rates will be \$10 per child per one hour class, with a minimum of 5 children and a maximum of 10 children per class. There is no minimum or maximum number of classes required. Classes can be scheduled weekly, bi-weekly, monthly or whenever best suits the group, however regularly scheduled groups will receive precedence.

In the event that Panhandle Gymnastics travels away from the gym to instruct classes a charge of .54/mile will be added to each class.

DRESS CODE

Girls

Leotard and bare feet is recommended. Tight fitting athletic active wear is acceptable. Comfortable clothing is acceptable. Tights are acceptable as long as they have no feet. No metal zippers, belts, etc.

Boys

Sweat suit, or "T" shirt, shorts, and bare feet. For the safety of your gymnast we recommend tight fitting athletic active wear.

Hair MUST be tied back and kept out of the gymnasts' eyes.

No jewelry

Cubbies are provided but we are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Enrollments

Each individual student within the group must create an account on our website, acknowledge our waivers and forms, and sign up for the group class. The group enrollment fee may be paid on site, or by one of the accounts in the group.

ARRIVING AND DEPARTING

Group leaders are responsible for dropping off and picking up their children, unless otherwise notated on your enrollment form.

PROPER CONDUCT

It is imperative that everyone involved in gymnastics- participants, group leaders, parents, caregivers, coaches, and visitors respect the following conduct rules and guidelines:

Treat others with respect.

Respect the personal space of others

Respect the property of others

Speak politely.

Follow directions.

Use equipment properly.

Allow class to run without unwarranted interruptions.

Only enrolled participants and coaches are permitted to be on the gymnastics floor and equipment.

Gymnasts are only permitted onto the gymnastics floor when invited to do so by a coach.

Running in the gym is prohibited- unless playing an authorized game, vaulting, or tumbling.

Families and parents are welcome to watch from the waiting area. Only enrolled students may enter the floor area or use the equipment.

Spectators may cross the floor along the wall in a safe manner to use the restrooms.
